

Volunteers needed to monitor the health of The River Cray



Thames21, London Wildlife Trust and ZSL are offering training in the **River Monitoring Initiative** (RMI) sampling method.

The RMI is a national scheme for monitoring the health of rivers. In order to be trained in the RMI you must be able to sample the river for at least 6 months. Once at the river, monthly samples take about 45 minutes.

In the training you will learn:

- The aims the River Cray RMI scheme
- How to kick sample a river.
- How to identify river invertebrates.
- What to do with the RMI data.

You will also meet other volunteers working to protect the River Cray.
